The workshop provides feedback, guidance and an opportunity to work with an interdisciplinary group of faculty and students. Participants read and discuss each other's proposals and engage in sessions about the rhetoric of proposal writing, methodological questions, writing for an interdisciplinary audience and other professional issues.
