Abstracts and papers may be submitted in Spanish, Portuguese, or English. Abstracts may be individual or collective, but in any case they must be original. Individual presentations may not exceed 20 minutes (7-8 double spaced / 12 point pages maximum), and panels should be limited to one hour.

Please submit an abstract of 250-500 words by e-mail to [spp\\_conf@berkeley.edu](mailto:spp_conf@berkeley.edu) no later than December 15<sup>th</sup>, 2009. The body of the e-mail should include the title of the presentation, your name(s), institutional affiliation, address, e-mail address and phone number. The abstract should be send as a Microsoft Word attachment, with no personal information other than the title of the paper. Participants will be notified of acceptance by February 15<sup>th</sup>, 2010.
